Facts of Lice

For Your Home

- Head lice are not living in your home, on your furniture or in your bedding. Without blood from your head, they can only live 24-48 hours.
- Place items that have been in contact with head lice in a dryer on high heat for 25-30 minutes (e.g. bedding, pillows, recent clothing).
- Vacuum or use a lint roller on items that can't be dried.
- Items that can't be dried or vacuumed should be set aside for 48 hours.
- Never spray with harmful pesticides.
- Clean hair out of brushes and either soak in soapy water, alcohol, or put in the freezer overnight.

For Your Head

- To succeed in eliminating a head lice infestation, all lice and nits must be removed using a special lice comb.
- Focusing on the head, rather than the environment is key.
- Comb hair with conditioner in shower 3 days during the week.
- Make sure to call us or do your own follow up 7-10 days later.
- It is normal to find a few nits for several days. Keep combing.
- Wash your clothes and your child's clothes thoroughly after nitpicking

Magnified Nit

- Head lice are small and wingless
- Lice do not fly or jump. They are only passed through contact.
- Female adult louse can lay 3-8 eggs per day.
- Nits take 7-10 days to hatch; 7-10 days to become adults.
- Nits are brown, attached firmly to the hair shaft like glue, off to one side and always oval in shape.
